Peer Review Process for Submissions for Presentation at any One Voice International Conference and Forum and all One Voice Publications including The (annual) One Voice International Collection of Scholarly Works and (2012) The One Voice Global Digital Library

One Voice utilizes a double blind peer review process executed as follows:

- Every scholarly work submitted to One Voice is reviewed by a member of the paper review committee for completeness including citations of sources, appropriateness of academic subject matter, credentials of the author, and other critical details.
- Two other reviewers (selected based on their relevant credentials to the subject matter) are called upon to evaluate the content of every submission against criteria including completeness including format and citations, appropriateness, scholarly value/contribution to the field of study, credentials of the author, academic tone, etc.
- Submitters are anonymous to reviewers, and vice versa to support the double-blind review methodology established by One Voice to ensure fair and impartial reviews/acceptances/rejections.
- All reviewers are educators have earned doctoral and other advanced degrees, in some cases multiple doctoral degrees.
- Most reviews are conducted within 48-72 hours from submission and feedback provided shortly thereafter, a standard set by the One Voice Board of Directors out of respect for submitting educators.
